Our President, Dr. Suman K Aggarwal, Sr. VP, Mrs N Rishi, VP, Mr S M Sethi, AGM Election Officer, Mrs Neeru Mehra were physically present as hosts, along with a skeleton Staff, maintaining due COVID 19 protocol. Our VP began the Meeting by warmly welcoming the Members, followed by the President presenting the Minutes of the last AGM which were ratified by the Members. After this, Mrs Mehra announced the election results of the Shanti Sahyog Executive Body for the years 2021 & 2022. Dr. Aggarwal then presented the Annual Report interspersed with first-hand accounts of the beneficiaries of our Projects in Education, Vocational Training & Women Empowerment. Our VP proposed the vote of thanks after which the Meeting was adjourned by the President.

A Milestone: On 31 March 2021, we completed one year of providing: Legal Awareness/Counseling/Aid & Rehabilitation to Domestic Violence Victims (DVV) living in our catchment area of 17 slums around our Centre for Women, in Kalkaji, supported by Azim Prem ji Philanthropic Initiatives (APPI). Our most significant achievement of last year, can be expressed in one key word: TRUST, which we have been able to build with the DVV's. This is evident from the continuing overwhelming response from our slum community. Initially, there was a lot of hesitancy, apprehension and skepticism amongst the DVV's to discuss their domestic violence issues with our Mobilizer, Counsellor and Advocate during our weekly Legal Awareness Camps (LAC). Along with doubting our intention to help them, the DVVs feared further victimization, if their perpetrators would come to know of their complaints against them. But through our reassurance, they mustered the courage to speak their truth to power, and avail legal help, from our Centre. The DVV's are now empowered enough to Dial 100 to bring the police to their doorstep & file a FIR or resort to legal action.



Having become conscious of their legal rights, they have overcome the feeling of victimhood, and now seek equality with their husbands and in-laws and display a strong will to take control of and remake their lives productively. Thus, the DVV's willingly and freely sharedt their tragic stories with Hatib from APPI, who visited our Centre on 26 Feb 2021, answering all his queries unhesitatingly. Further, they were bold enough to recount their stories and encourage other women to speak out against domestic violence and injustice, at our well-attended International Women Day Event on 8 March 2021.

Moving on to the 2nd year of our project starting 1 April instant to date, 362 women have been mobilized, our weekly LAC were attended by 56 beneficiaries in April and 91 in June and we registered and counselled 49 cases of DV. Though no LAC were held during the lockdown from 19 April to 6 June 2021, our Counsellor conducted 5 counseling sessions online.









Victim to Victorious

Pooja, Tarannum & Nazbeen are a few names from the list of many such victorious survivors who fought their way to freedom from being a domestic violence victim, under our APPI Project. Out of **902 women** who attended the **41 Legal Awareness Camps** organized in F/Y 2020-21, we gave Vocational Training to **200** and **rehabilitated 124** brave souls who have now stepped into leading self-dependent fearless lives.

No matter the size of this number, it is a big achievement for us to impact even a single life. When we reached out to these girls, we were happy to note their positive state of mind full of big plans & dreams of the future.

They are still coping with their traumatic pasts and so did not agree to be published on this platform but were glad to hear from us & exchange a flame of trust which glows brighter with every passing moment!

The journey of outreach doesn't end here. As our vision clearly states:

A world free from poverty & violence

and that world is being created with manifold communities and with many such souls.

Since November 2019, Shanti Sahyog Centre for Women, TKD Village, is partnering with Tribhovandas Bhimji Zaveri Ltd. (TBZ) flagship CSR Project PANKHI, to help Domestic Violence Victims (DVV) through Counselling, Legal Aid & Outreach Activities which include:

- Legal Awareness Camps to educate women of their legal rights;
- Capacity Development of women with leadership qualities, to guide DVV's to our Centre to seek aid;
- **Providing temporary shelter** to DVV's through women organizations;
- Conducting premarital workshops & Training in Self-Defence;
- To facilitate reporting of gender-based violence cases through a Central Helpline Service;
- To organise webinars for NGO's, Corporates, Women's Organizations, University students, etc on domestic violence/abuse and info about TBZ Project PANKHI.



We are happy to report that TBZ not only renewed our Project for another year in Nov 2020, but also provided additional funding in March 2021 to rehabilitate 50 DVV's annyally through Vocational Training. From Jan to June 2021, we have conducted 39 Outreach Sessions, benefitting 882 women. Total No. of Registered Cases: 10; Unregistered Cases 31. Kudos to our Counsellor - Amrita Sawhney, Advocate - Manju Bala & Community Outreach Agent - Nisha for successfully implementing PANKHI.

Dr.Prakash Chander Khanduja – Our Dr. Sahib!



Dr. Sahib and Shanti Sahyog share their birthday - 30th September. No wonder then there is an amazing bond between the two, since 2nd April 2007, when Dr. Sahib joined our Health Centre, as our cum pediatrician. Born in 1937 in a small village Ragin, Pakistan, to Maya Devi & Ganga Ram, a khetizamindaar, Dr. Sahib trudged 3 km daily to attend primary school in the nearest town Phaalia, Gujarat, where the medium of instruction was Urdu. So, when his family relocated to Bilaspur, India, during partition, on 12th August 1947, he had to learn Hindi before joining School here. However, he reminiscences, his teachers were very pleased with him, as he was the only boy in his class fluent in English! He nostalgic childhood has memories of their haveli in Pakistan, surrounded by fields of seasonal vegetables, sugar cane and fruit - melons, watermelons and mangoes. They owned cows and buffalos and so enjoyed an abundance of milk, butter, butter-milk and ghee.

But he had not seen a car until he came to India!

Being one of the 5 top scorers in his School Intermediate Exams, he was awarded a scholarship for his MBBS studies in Jabalpur Medical College. After MBBS, on 16 July 1964, he enrolled for Diploma Child Health in Maulana Azad Medical College Delhi. On his first night duty here, he was catapulted to fame when he expertly started 30 dehydrated children on drips in a few minutes, using steel needles available at that time - small vein needles were scalp invented later. The next day Dr. Shanti Ghosh complimented "very nimble him on his, fingers". His reputation grew so much, that he was invited by PM Indira Gandhi to take 9month-old Rahul Gandhi's blood sample, as he was a very chubby baby and his veins were not visible. Though nervous, Dr. Sahib impressed Sonia Gandhi, by taking the blood sample in one prick! Dr. Sahib says he is indebted to Dr. P N Taneja, because he learnt a lot from him as his assistant.

joined Banaras Hindu He University in Jan 1969 as a lecturer, but soon resigned because of, "too much politics". He returned to Delhi to start his own private practice, and joined later Mool Chand Senior Hon hospital as Consultant in July 1976. working there for a quarter of

a century – till 2001. While at Mool Chand, he also volunteered twice a week in mobile creche NGO, providing medical services in JJ colonies in Janakpuri, Seemapuri and migrant labour construction camps. He vividly remembers seeing 5 star hotels – Taj Palace & Maurya –being built in the vicinity of the Camps.

Dr. Sahib's compassion, dedication, work-ethics, hard work, honesty, generosity and not craving materialistic returns are exemplary. Like Mool Chand hospital Staff, Shanti Sahyog Staff was also sad to see him retire. It is Dr. Sahib's zeal to serve and untiring efforts that have made our Health Centre a big success. For almost a decade, he provided his services 6 days a week rain or shine, attending to over 5,000/patients annually. Besides his work ethics, his extraordinary sense of humour and expertise in Urdu shayari, endeared him to us. It is with great pride, he has been chosen for,

We wish him a long and healthy life, with Kamla ji - his very supportive wife, surrounded with love and affection from his 2 daughters, Rita and Anju, son Anuj, 5 grand-children and extended Shanti Sahyog family! On a personal note,

I deeply cherish my association with him. He continues to make me laugh and pampers me by sending occasional gifts of select vegetables and fruit.
