

31 March 2022 marked the successful completion of the 2nd Year of Azim Premji Philanthropy Initiatives (APPI) supported Project: Legal Awareness / Counselling / Aid / Rehabilitation of Domestic Violence Victims (DVV's) living in our catchment area of 17 slums, Kalkaji-Govindpuri, New Delhi. A significant achievement in the last 6 months, is the Courageous **Transformation** of the DVV's from being helpless victims of domestic violence and abuse, to strong, empowered, resolute women, refusing to succumb to their misery. Now, for, some concrete figures: 4 Legal Awareness Camps (LAC) were held monthly; attended by 103 women in Jan, 75 in Feb, 103 in March, 102 in April, 137 in May & 111 in June 2022. From Jan to June 2022, 2560 women were Mobilized; 25 LAC were held attended by 631 slum women; 61 Cases of DVV's registered & counseled & 30 DVV's enrolled in Vocational Skills for Rehabilitation.





30 March 2022 Ashmeet Kaur & Hatib Ashraf from APPI, visited to review our Project. They interacted with our Beneficiaries - both DVV's & Survivors. Their visit was very fruitful in providing mentorship & guidance to our Team. During April, May & June 2022, we forged the following valuable partnerships: National Commission for Women; *Mahila Panchayat*, Kalkaji; SHO Kalkaji & Govindpuri Police Stations; Delhi Legal Service Authority; Shakti Shalini (Shelter Home); Migration & Asylum Project. We secured funding for DVV's Nursing Course in Jamia Hamdard from Bal Arogya NGO & enrolled DVV's in National Institute of Open Schooling.






