# **Shanti Sahyog implements Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna**

On 3 August 2015 we enrolled our 1<sup>st</sup> Batch of students in *Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna* - Prime Minister's Skill Development Scheme, a new Central Govt Vocational Training initiative. The objective is to train Class X and Class XII students - especially drop outs - as first time entrants to the labour market, in various job specific skills which lead to livelihood opportunities for them and also contribute to the economy of the nation. The Training is free but the students have to deposit Rs. 800/- on enrollment. This amount will be refunded to their bank accounts after they are successfully certified.

The duration of the course is 45 days. Course Methodology has been developed by GIMIT, Training Partner of Logistic Skill Council Telecom Sector and Retailors Association's Skill Council of India. GIMIT is a Training & Development Company which has trained more than 50,000 Candidate since 2001. Shanti Sahyog is providing Training under the guidance of GIMIT.
