

The meeting ended on a very cordial note.

From the Editor's Desk

Dear Readers,

As 2012 dawns on us, a bit of reflection on the year past and a hopeful look at the year ahead. Time magazine declared 'The Protestor' as their 'Person of the Year 2011'. This is a resounding tribute to the rising power of ordinary citizens to catalyse social, political and economic change. This is also in line with *Gandhi's* view of power as popular (belonging to the people), not elitist (government). For our team at Shanti Sahyog, who are active supporters of *Anna Hazare's* anti corruption movement (please refer to our May–August 2011 Newsletter) Time's person of the year resonates deep. As an NGO engaged in the 'business' of bringing about change, we hope to carry this momentum into the year/s ahead as we bring hope and welfare to the most under served and marginalised in our society.

For us at Shanti Sahyog, 2011 saw several highlights. Here are a few:

- Our children will finally travel safely and in comfort to and from their school Deepalya in their brand new school bus that was generously donated to us by Engineers India Limited.
- We established The Gender Resource Center (GRC) at Govindpuri servicing 15 slums in South Delhi. The range of work spans from non-formal education and vocational training to legal and medical aid and assistance in access to government welfare schemes.
- The GRC also enabled 7,000 slum dwellers to procure Unique Identification Cards (UID). A further 983 people were insured under the Rashtriya Swasthya Beema Yojna for the nominal cost of Rs. 30 covering 5 members of a family for upto Rs 30,000 each for 1 year. GRC also started training school drop-outs (mainly boys) in the Swaran Jayanti Shehri Rojgar Yojna in the following trades: plumber, electrician, backhoe loader, crane operator, fashion designer, computer literacy.
- 5,000 slum dwellers had access to medical help through our Health Center thanks to the dedication of our medical specialist Dr. PC Khanduja.
- Our Play/Pre School completed three years this September and got a long overdue makeover thanks to the Lioness Club, South Delhi (Kalkaji).
- Our Computer Training Center got a much needed boost as Engineers India Limited gave us 12 old and 5 brand new computers.
- Summer of 2011 saw a bevy of volunteers coming for field experience in Shanti Sahyog from different schools and colleges – Summer Fields School - Kailash Colony, DPS R K Puram, Mother's International School - Sri Aurobindo Marg, IIT Delhi, BITS Pilani, and Mata Sundri College. We also had 20 National Service Scheme (NSS) volunteers from Lady Sri Ram College (LSR)
- Our 200 school children are one year closer towards a life free of the poverty their parents have lived through, thanks to the continuous support of our corporate, PSU and individual donors who help us fund their education. For more information on the wide range of our activities, please refer to our Annual Report 2011.
