

Inauguration of Shanti Sahyog Dental Centre

On 13th March 2014, our Dental Centre was formally inaugurated by Ms Lisa Usback, Consul-General, Australian High Commission. We had invited HE Mr Patrick Suckling, High Commissioner of Australia to do so, but he was unable to spare the time due to his busy schedule. Ms Lisa Usback was accompanied by Kate Sullivan, 2nd Secretary (Political), DAP Chair and Prerna Seth, DAP Co-ordinator. A journalist was also present on the occasion. On her arrival at the Clinic, Ms Lisa Usback was warmly welcomed by our President, Sr. Vice President and Shanti Sahyog Staff. After inaugurating our Dental Centre, Ms Lisa Usback inspected it carefully and enquired in detail about its working from our dentist, Dr. Deepti Khanna. She also interacted keenly with some of the slum beneficiaries to ascertain how they had benefitted by the dental treatment at the Centre. She was quite pleased with their feedback. Kate Sullivan briefed the journalist about DAP funded Projects.

Though it took some time to find the proper location for our Dental Centre as it had to be **easily accessible** to the dwellers of the 17 slums we work in, it has gradually become popular. In the past six months, 127 persons have sought treatment. As was the intent, poor people have benefitted by this Centre as they have been able to get dental care and treatment at very subsidized costs. The information about our Centre has spread greatly by word of mouth through our beneficiaries who are very satisfied by their treatment. We foresee our Centre acquiring a great reputation and clientele with the passage of time. We once again thank the Australian High Commission, for helping us realise our goal of providing dental care at affordable rates to the underprivileged!

Since the past decade, our Gandhian NGO - Shanti Sahyog, has been serving the underprivileged in 17 urban slums of Delhi (Kalkaji/Govindpuri area) with a focus on women and children in the areas of literacy, health care and women empowerment. We are empanelled with the **National CSR Hub**, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Bombay and recipient of **Rajiv Gandhi Global Vision Award 2012**, **Karmayeer Puruskaar 2013**, & International Women Excellence Award 2013 & 2014.

Why we need a Corpus Fund

So far our work has been facilitated through funding from various governmental and private agencies and individual donators. As we have grown in our programs and scope of beneficiaries we are very often left stranded, when promised funding fails to materialize or there are month long delays in delivery of funds. Most of our project workers are supporting their families on the not very generous salaries that they are given by Shanti Sahyog. We believe that it is their right as an employee to be paid on time and with respect to their work. With inconsistent and inadequate funding we are always insecure about the future of our projects and our employees.

To secure our independence and to allow us to keep serving our disadvantaged brothers and sisters, we have decided to build a **Corpus Fund for the Shanti Sahyog Education Project for Urban Slum Children**.
